#### **Presidential Transition Plan**

- Kay Clinard announced his retirement from the UCAlug effective 31 December 2019.
- A directors only BoD meeting was later held on 3 December 2019 to discuss recruitment of a replacement for Kay.
  - Board members present at this private meeting: Ralph Mackiewicz, Aaron Snyder, Chavdar Ivanov, David Bogen, Gerald Gray, Stuart Laval, and Zeus Xioco
  - With a unanimous vote, BoD appointed Margaret Goodrich as the President of the UCAlug effective 1 January 2020.
  - The board also unanimously authorized the appointment of Kay Clinard to the honorary position of President Emeritus of the UCAlug and the purchase of a suitable award to commemorate Kay's long-standing service and dedication to the UCAlug. An announcement will be posted on the UCAlug site.



#### **ITCA Concerns from Testers**

- Some UCAlug members had privately expressed concerns to the Chair and VP Operations regarding UCAlug's plans to become an ITCA and suggested that some testers would no longer be involved in UCAlug testing if fulfilled.
- Chair has repeatedly requested additional information regarding which at the time of the meeting had not yet been provided.
- No action possible right now until additional information is provided.
- The members have been informed that this topic has been brought up repeatedly at BoD meetings.

#### 2019 IOPs and PlugFest

- IEC 61850, CIM, and OpenFMB testing activities occurred week of September 23<sup>rd</sup> in Charlotte, NC.
  - IEC 61850 and OpenFMB yielded good results and participation
  - CIM IOP was sponsored/initiated by EPRI and lack of participation prevented testing.
    - CIM IOP rescheduled for March 2020.
    - 2019 participants didn't any testing for the money paid
    - Learning moment: Simultaneous IOPs not a good idea

**Testing Quality Improvement** 

- UCAlug Board authorized investigation and establishment of a UCAlug Interoperability Testing & Certification Authority (ITCA) process based upon ISO 17025 processes.
  - Interoperability Testing (well underway)
  - Improve quality of IEC 61850 accreditation and certification process.
  - Establish processes for CIM and OpenFMB.

Proposed next steps:

- Go to UCAlug members to see if additional quality is desired (e.g. is it worth the cost).
- Based upon feedback, discuss with current accredited test labs.
- Start developing process and test procedures for OpenFMB.



ITCA request for another technology:

- MESA (via Frances Cleveland) has requested that UCAlug be the ITCA for MESA (mapping of IEC 61850 data attributes to DNP indexes).
  - Have reached out to labs to see if anybody is interested in assisting writing test procedures and doing testing. Response has been negative.
  - Unable to envision a self-sustaining process from a cost perspective.
  - Will be responding that UCAlug will not provide the service.



#### **Reorganization Issues**

- Lack of Active Executive Committee
  - Liaisons and endorsements
    - Endorsing private events
    - IEC and others endorsing UCAlug events
  - Marketing functions like communication of purpose and benefits
  - Membership promotional activities
- Board approved unanimously the following:
  - Establish a re-organization committee (comprising Aaron Snyder, Ralph Mackiewicz and Margaret Goodrich) to develop a proposal for approval by the membership outlining changes in the bylaws and charter necessary to dissolve the Executive Committee and place its functions under the authority of the Board of Directors.
  - The BoD will perform these activities with the support of UCAlug staff in the meantime.



**Endorsement of Smart Grid Forums** 

- UCAlug has been asked to formally endorse Smart Grid Forum's <u>IEC 61850</u> and <u>CIM</u> conferences and establish a strategic partnership with same for the future.
- Exact benefits TBD but would involve visibility on web site (logo) and potential speaking opportunities regarding UCAlug.
- Immediate action postponed but will be considered in future BoD meetings.



#### UCAlug Logo Usage Rules

- Requests to use UCAlug logos for members to use to identify themselves as member have been received
- Staff needs direction on approved usage lacking a formal marketing subcommittee to decide
- Board motion was passed unanimously to establish the following policy regarding member usage of UCAIug logos:
  - Members of the UCAlug may use UCAlug logos in a reasonable manner, and without formal approval on a case by case basis, for the sole purpose of identifying themselves as members of the UCAlug. Notwithstanding this policy, any member shall also discontinue any use of any UCAlug logo upon request from the UCAlug staff or directors.
- UCAlug staff was directed to created usage documents for members in compliance with this policy.



#### Formal Separation of Green Button & UCAlug

- Paperwork formally separating the organizations has been submitted to the State of North Carolina.
- Awaiting response and confirmation



#### **CIM-UML Intellectual Property Issues**

- CIMug publishes CIM UML on the web site for public access
- IEC has declared the CIM UML as a "code component" and should only be available as a copyrighted machine-readable document subject to IEC license grants to those purchasing the standards
- IEC originally thought that UCAlug transferred IP rights to the CIM UML when the liaison was established
- However, the original IP of the CIM UML was authored by EPRI, not UCAlug
- BoD and CIMug leadership consider open access to the CIM UML is critical to the continued use of the CIM by utilities and vendors



#### **CIM-UML IP Activity**

- EPRI and IEC have been in discussions without resolution
- EPRI has offered to <u>license UCAlug with its IP rights</u> under Apache 2.0 open source license
- UCAlug staff obtained legal opinion that acceptance of this would not increase the legal jeopardy of UCAlug even though publishing under Apache license may not comply with IEC desires
- The BoD approved directing the President of the UCAlug to execute the EPRI License grant after review with legal and to publish the CIM UML under the Apache 2.0 License on the UCAlug site per the license grant. The vote was: 7 voted yes, 0 voted no, 1 abstention.



#### **OpenFMB** Apache Licensing Update

- Previous individual Apache Contributors Agreement is being expanded for corporate members
- Agreements will be posted on the OpenFMB site
